WEEKLY FOCUS: LANGUAGE & LITERACY

Pray that God's word would be on the lips and in the hearts of the Alagwa of Tanzania. Pray that the audio recordings of Bible stories that are available in Alagwaisa would be widely listened to.



Pray that lives would be changed as a result of encounters with the living God.

30 JULY | SUNDAY

At the moment many Alagwa are bound to a form of Islam that incorporates ideas from traditional African religions. They fear evil spirits who have real power over their lives. Pray that many would come to know freedom from their bondage through Christ and be able to accept Jesus as their deliverer.

31 JULY | MONDAY

Pray for Alagwa believers, that they would be able to stand strong in their decision to follow Christ especially in the face of opposition from their family and friends. Pray they would be an example to others who want to follow Jesus but who are scared of being different to their community.

9 JULY | SUNDAY

13 JULY | THURSDAY

Pray for good succession planning and wise delegation of duties across AIM, whether from leadership to successors, or missionaries to nationals. Pray for the ability to let go of responsibilities and for others to be teachable and willing to step up to a change of role.

14 JULY | FRIDAY

Pray that God would clearly call people to serve as leaders, and that they would not only hear but humbly obey. Pray for good, relevant training, and appropriate ways of preparing and providing ongoing support, appropriate to each person and their situation.

15 JULY | SATURDAY
