



Using coloured A4 paper, mark out triangle strips widthways across the bottom. The thick end should be 3cm. Cut them out using scissors. If you want smaller beads for a bracelet, do them 1-2cm.



Apply a thin layer of PVA glue to one side of the triangle. Roll the paper around the inside of a ballpoint pen or thin paintbrush, with the glued side facing down. Make sure to keep the sides even.

WHY NOT

cut smaller strips of paper and make a bracelet instead?



Once you have enough beads, thread them onto string to make your necklace or bracelet. You could paint them with varnish to protect them from getting wet!
