

Fold a square piece of paper in half both lengths and sideways, unfolding it each time.


Turn it over, and fold up the two corners on the other side too, making a diamond.


Turn the right hand side flap as if you are turning over the page of a book. Turn over and repeat.


Push your finger into the gap and squash the paper down along the folds you just made.


Turn the paper over, then fold in half along the diagonal lines, unfolding it each time.


Fold the top point of the triangle on each side down to the bottom point, and then unfold.


Fold each of the outside edges into the middle.
 fold (shown above) inwards, allowing the creases to fold.


Push your finger into the gap and and squash the paper down along the folds you just made.


Flatten each side down so that the triangles are now square shapes.


Turn the right hand side flap as if you are turning over the page of a book. Turn over and repeat.


You have your origami church!


Turn over and then repeat the folds on the other side.


Fold up the centre triangle along the line.


You should end up with a shape that is a traingle when laid flat.


Turn the paper over and do the same to the two traingles on the other side.


Fold down each inner corner diagonally down to the edge, make a crease, and then unfold.


Your church should stand up with the flaps behind. the creases to create a traingle shape on both the left and right side.
