

MAKE A SALT DOUGH HANGER

Make your own salt dough hanger. Fun and easy to make decorations!

You will need:

- · 2 cups of flour
- · 1 cup of salt
- · 1 cup of water

- · Cookie cutters
- · Stamps, paint or an ink pad
- · A pencil or similar to make a hole
- · Ribbon or string
- Set your oven to 100°C (Get an adult to help).
- Mix the dry ingredients.
- Gradually add the water and mix.
- Roll the dough out (1/2cm thick).
- If you are using stamps, put ink on them and press them into the dough.
- Cut shapes out with your cutters.
- Place the shapes onto a baking sheet.
- Using a skewer or pencil, make a hole to hang them up later.
- Bake in the oven at 100°C for two to three hours or until they are hard.
- Let them cool.
- Add a ribbon or string.

Add extra details with pens, paint or glitter and then varnish them to stop your design coming off.
